The supply assignments will have varying start and end dates, and hours of work.

Overall Role

The Elementary and Secondary Program Teacher is responsible for the overall program delivery at the Lac des Mille Lacs Education Centre's School. The Elementary and Secondary Program Teacher will ensure that the students who attend have the programming and supports that meet their own unique educational, emotional, social and physical needs. The Elementary and Secondary Program Teacher reports directly to the School Principal and Education Director.

Required Skills & Qualifications

In order to be considered for this position, applicants must possess the following:

- 1) Bachelor of Arts/Science and Bachelor of Education or a Bachelor of Education.
- 2) Valid Ontario Teaching Certificate / Membership with the Ontario College of Teachers
- 3) Knowledge of curriculum, instructional and assessment strategies
- 4) Minimum of 3 years' successful teaching experience in K to grade 8 and/or grade 7 to grade 12
- 5) Experience with the development and implementation of First Nation language and cultural programming/courses would be an asset.
- 6) Excellent management, planning and organizational skills are required.
- 7) Experience in the education of Anishinaabe students/adults.
- 8) Valid driver's license and access to a vehicle is an asset.
- 9) Fluency in the Anishinaabe Language is an asset.
- 10) Vulnerable sector check is required.

Along with their resume and cover letter, applicants must submit a current copy of Ontario College of Teachers Certificate, vulnerable sector check and three references.
