- Earth Foundations & Anchors (buried timber/steel grillages)
- Rock Foundations & Anchors
- Helical Pile Foundations & Anchors
- Driven Pile Foundations & Anchors
- Micro-pile Foundations & Overburden Grouted Anchors

Qualifications/Experience:

- Experience in Quality Assurance/Quality Control
- Ability to read, interpret and apply Codes, Standards, Specifications and Drawings
- Experience in monitoring foundation installations
- Powerline experience is considered an asset
- Foundation testing experience (Concrete/Grout, PDA, etc.) is considered an asset
- Experience in computers and technology with exposure to MS Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint & Outlook)
- High School Diploma
