ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEACHERS – OJIBWAY IMMERSION PROGRAM**

***Position Summary***

Lac des Mille Lacs First Nation (LDMLFN) is seeking creative, dynamic professional(s) to join the First Nation's Education Centre team to teach our curriculum program to elementary students in the Ojibway Immersion language stream.

Lac des Mille Lacs First Nation is currently offering an Ojibway Immersion Language Program at I.R. Churchill Elementary. The goal of Language Immersion streams is to develop proficiency in the Ojibway Language. Within the program, students will learn and develop an understanding and appreciation for the Anishinaabe culture. The curriculum content will be the same as the Ontario English curriculum, except that students will receive their classroom instruction in the Ojibway or Non-Immersion streams and there is a strong focus on land-based instruction.

***Overall Role***

The Elementary Ojibway Immersion Teachers are responsible for delivering age appropriate curriculum at the Lac des Mille Lacs First Nation's I.R. Churchill Elementary School. The Elementary Ojibway Immersion Teacher(s) will ensure language, culture and land-based learning is central in our curriculum programs and service delivery. The Elementary Ojibway Immersion Teacher(s) report directly to the School Administrator and Education Director.

***Required Skills & Qualifications***

In order to be considered for this position, applicants must possess the following:

1. Bachelor of Education degree or Education diploma.
2. Membership with the Ontario College of Teachers.
3. Knowledge of curriculum and instructional strategies.
4. Minimum three years' successful teaching experience in the primary/junior or intermediates/senior divisions; teaching and learning strategies and experience in integrating language, culture and indigenous content into the Ontario curriculum is an asset.
5. Excellent management, planning and organizational skills are required.
6. Fluency in the Ojibway is a requirement.
7. Sensitivity to the values, beliefs and education needs of Anishinaabe students.
8. Valid driver's license and access to a vehicle.
9. Vulnerable sector check is required.

Along with their resume and cover letter, applicants must submit a current copy of Ontario College of Teachers Certificate, vulnerable sector check and three references.

## **GENERAL DUTIES**

Teaches the required school programs at LDMLFN's Elementary Ojibway Language Immersion Program and other school programs, as required.

- 1) Deliver the required curriculum with the integration of language, culture and land-based programming.
- 2) Develop and implement lesson plans that fulfill the requirements of the school's curriculum and reflect accommodations for differences in student learning styles.
- 3) Develop a personalized placement learning plan for each student.
- 4) Assess and evaluate student performance.
- 5) Keep dated, anecdotal records on student progress.
- 6) Establish and maintain efficient classroom management procedures.
- 7) Consistently evaluate and record various aspects of student's progress and communicate with parents on an on-going regular basis.
- 8) Identify student needs and collaboratively work with other staff members in assessing and assisting students in their development.
- 9) Follow all required policies and procedures.
- 10) Other duties as assigned by the School Administrator and/or Education Director.
