Background

The First Nation is in the process of re-developing its Reserve Lands and enhancing its various facilities. The Facilities Operation Worker – Youth Intern, will be responsible in assisting with the physical preparation required to hold successful cultural and community events and activities. These duties will include assisting in the maintenance of community and cultural sites, facilities and green spaces, and other duties as assigned.

Job Description

Duties will include: Working with the Cultural Assistant in GIS mapping, caring for and maintaining cultural sites, community development, small engine repairs and general maintenance.

Assisting in: Cultural activities (i.e.) Pow Wow, Elder's Gathering, various ceremonial activities; Reserve land re-habitation projects; cultural site, facilities and green space maintenance.

Required Qualifications

This position is open to individuals aged 15-30 years, who are full-time students, intending to return to their studies in the upcoming school year.

Preference will be given to candidates with an Educational background in Outdoor Recreation, Mechanical Technician or Trades, Tourism.

The successful candidate must have a valid driver's license and access to their own vehicle.
