

Thank you for your interest in powerline sector employment training with OSLP. Here is what you need to know!



The Wataynikaneyap Transmission Project Training Program is specifically designed to prepare participants for employment opportunities in the building of the Wataynikaneyap Powerline Project and the Powerline Sector. Women and men from all backgrounds and abilities are invited to apply to both training programs and will be given a training allowance (stipend).

Introduction to Powerline Construction and Work Readiness Training will be delivered in Wataynikaneyap owner First Nations over two weeks. The training certificate will include essential safety, budgeting and communication skills, an overview of the Wataynikaneyap Project and powerline industry and employment awareness and readiness, etc.

Line Crew Ground Support will be delivered in Thunder Bay over 15 weeks and participants need to have the support of their family to attend the training away from home. This specialized certificate course will include climbing at heights, operating equipment, classroom learning and training outdoors. Participants for this course must meet the following requirements:

√ Valid G driver's license √ Must be age 18+ √ Grade 12 diploma preferred

If interested, please submit your application even if you do not have the requirements and we will work together with your community to refer applicants to upgrading training as there will be several rounds of training until 2020. Driver's license testing may be available in your community. Applicants with a GED or certificate equivalent, or some high school and can demonstrate the required math and English skills, will be considered on a case by case basis.
