- Demonstrate the ability to position blocks and tie downs to secure cargo
- Travelling and acclimatizing to all types of weather conditions, whether night or day
- Driving carefully on hills and bad weather circumstances and managing the vehicle safely
- Agreeing to the protection rules and policies in transporting, handling, and supplying procedures and methods of fuel
- Examining the goods and ensuring that they meet all policies, rules, and regulations
- Have a valid Class A license and clean driving record
- Working around heavy equipment
- Physically fit with the ability to lift a minimum of 50 lbs.
- Able to work a minimum 20 days on with 8 days off in remote locations
- Potential to working longer shifts may be required
- Camp accommodations will be provided by Valard
- Transportation will be provided from your home community to the camp accommodations and then at the end of your shift transportation will be provided back to your community by Valard
