This 6 week program offers a wide variety of rewarding opportunities. The Remote Camp Support Worker program is designed to provide the trainee with the knowledge and skills to effectively support and assist the Camp Manager with daily duties including cook preparation, cleaning, serving, customer service and maintenance.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

This program provides the basic knowledge and skills required for any entry-level position in a remote camp location.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Have a minimum of a Grade 10 education
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Complete appropriate application forms and assessments prior to training
- Successful completion of Energy Readiness: Intro to Energy (2-Week, Online) prior to start date

COURSE INFORMATION

This course will run daily Monday to Friday – 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. – for 6 weeks. Students will be provided with all personal protective equipment (PPE).

CREDENTIALS

At the successful completion of the program, participants will receive a Confederation College "Recognition of Completion".
