PROGRAM INFO

A full Class AZ (air brake endorsement) truck licence lets you drive:

- Any truck/tractor-trailer combination
- A combination of motor vehicle and towed vehicles where the towed vehicles exceed a total gross weight of 4,600 kg (10,000 lbs) and has air brakes
- A vehicle pulling double trailers
- A car or light truck covered by a Class G licence
- Heavy trucks covered by the Class D truck licence
- Any vehicle covered under a restricted Class A truck licence
- A Class A licence does not allow you to drive a bus carrying passengers, a motorcycle or a moped
